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**ON SEMANTIC SEGMENTATION OF SPOKEN LANGUAGE DISCOURSE (REGARDING
EXPERIMENTAL MATERIAL WITH SPECIAL MODIFICATIONS)¹**

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This paper is aimed at carrying out a research and modelling prosodic-semantic-pragmatic variability of speech discourse. The initial point of the given research is based on linguistic consciousness of communicative process partners. The material is the German language. Such aspects of the multicomponent (linguistic, para-, extralinguistic) mechanism of sense decoding of the spoken speech in discourse with due regard to such form of spoken activity as a spontaneous polylogue were considered. Participants of the experiment were native (Russian and German) speakers. The informants were differentiated by sex, age, social and educational upbringing. The methods include the following types of spoken corpus analysis: perceptive-acoustic, semantic, and also a method of modelling prosodic-semantic units of spoken language discourse on the basis of a speech communication concept developed by R.K. Potapova. This concept is based on three components: communication, information and cybernetics.

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
